75% of our energy is provided by 144 photo-voltaic panels. This has saved over 347,600 lbs (158,000 kg) of carbon emissions so far.

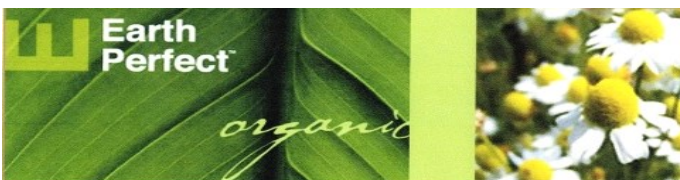
Each guest cottage sits atop two 17,000 gallon cisterns to collect rain water for use at the resort. Solar water heaters supply all the showers and the waste water is then re-used for garden irrigation.

Our waste water is processed by a state-of-the-art Submerged Membrane Bio-Reactor.

This custom-built system produces over 1000 gallons a day of recycled, clean water for garden irrigation and the cleaning of boats.



We use eco-friendly detergent and cleaning products from Sanitation Solutions in the US Virgin Islands, plus 'Earth Perfect' organic room amenities.



The guest rooms are all fan cooled, not air-conditioned. Solid Teak four-poster beds feature Martex 'Eco Pure' pillows and mattress covers made from recycled plastic bottles.



The restaurant's tables are also reclaimed teak and the bar stools and chairs are made from decommissioned fishing boats.



Our disposable cups, cutlery, straws and take-out boxes are made from corn, not petroleum-derived plastic.

All kitchen and restaurant food waste goes to feed the pigs raised by the Leonard family on Cooper Island.

Tree trimmings & vegetable peelings and are turned into compost and mulch for the gardens.

We grow bananas, plantain, papaya, passion fruit, okra, squash, peppers and herbs for the kitchen to try and reduce our food importation.
