

## Workplace / Business Checklist

Inside Checklist:

Cisterns Seal cistern with tightly fitted concrete covers. Outlets and down-spouts should be sealed with mosquito netting.
Buckets and pails Bucket and other types of containers used to store water indoors should be tightly covered with mosquito netting or cheese-cloth.
Flower pots with saucers Weekly empty and wipe saucers clean to eliminate and mosquitoes breeding in the water collected
Shower drains Outlets should be sealed with mosquito netting, under drain cover
Outdoor Checklist:
Containers for storing water Keep them securely covered, screened or taped at all times with mosquito netting or cheese-cloth.
<b>Discarded / Unused items</b> - buckets, laundry tanks, sinks, face basins and toilet bowls Dispose of items or turnover and/or secure under shelter if needed
Concrete blocks, tree holes / bromeliads Fill up with concrete, gravel or sand.
Roof guttering Clean weekly to ensure that dirt and leaves do not collect rainwater and encourage mosquitoes to breed in them.
Old tyres Secure them under shelter if needed for future use, bore holes in them, recycle or dispose of them at the garbage dump or
<b>Gardening equipment</b> (water pans, shovels,wheelbarrows and the like) Secure under shelter or turn over to prevent water collection.
Vegetation/tall Grass Regularly debush and clear vegetation around your property which will prevent the harboring of mosquitoes
Unused / Derelict Boats Cover or upturn any unused boats to ensure water does not collect inside. If the boat is clearly derelict, please contact the BVI department of waste or report it to BugOut.
Unused / Derelict Vehicles Unused vehicles should be Derelict vehicles should be properly disposed of, to ensure water does not collect inside. Contact the BVI department of waste or report it to RugOut who will arrange for the vehicle to be disposed of
