MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT,
GOVERNMENT OF THE VIRGIN ISLANDS

And

GREEN VI

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) confirms an understanding and outlines the terms of cooperation between the Government of the Virgin Islands (hereinafter referred to as "the Government") of the ONE PART and Green VI, a BVI registered Non-Profit Organisation of the OTHER PART, for the purpose of facilitating a Recycling Pilot for the Virgin Islands. The term "Partners" will refer to the collective parties to the MOU.

Whereas the Government is seeking to provide support for increased waste diversion and recycling activity in the Virgin Islands in accordance with the Government's Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Strategy;

Whereas the Government aims to encourage greater levels of involvement in recycling activities by Green VI and other operators and recognises the contribution already being made in this area;

Whereas Green VI is committed to providing innovative upcycling and traditional technologies for recycling throughout the Virgin Islands and has updated its Recycling Pilot since the passage of Hurricanes Irma and Maria in 2017; and

Whereas Green VI has mobilised funding to catalyse a recycling system for Virgin Gorda, and is set to raise additional funds to expand recycling efforts to the rest of the Virgin Islands.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED BETWEEN THE PARTIES:

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this MOU is to create a mutually beneficial working relationship of cooperation between the Partners in order to implement a Recycling Pilot and cooperatively work towards the development of a community-based Recycling System for the Virgin Islands.

- Prepare designs and development strategies for the establishment of materials recovery facilities (MRFs) and eco-parks in the Virgin Islands;
- Mobilize supplementary funding to support the essential components of a Recycling System in the Virgin Islands.

The Government of the Virgin Islands, through the Department of Waste Management under the Ministry of Health and Social Development, agrees to:

- Collect recyclable materials from agreed collection points;
- Transport selected recyclable materials to designated processing sites;
- Provide skips for the collection of Glass, Plastic and Aluminum at Pockwood Pond;
- Operate, maintain and secure collections trucks provided by Green VI for the sole purpose of collecting recyclables on Virgin Gorda and Tortola;
- Return collection trucks to Green VI with documented records of all maintenance performed, upon the termination of this MOU.

4. ADDITIONAL TERMS

4.1 Effective Date


This MOU will come into effect upon the date of signature of the Parties and will continue in effect until terminated in accordance with clause 4.6.




